

Capistrano Valley High School PTSA Local Legislative Advocacy Agenda

1) To support equalization of school facilities within CUSD with the priority being safe and healthy environment for all children. To implement the EPA's "Tools for School's" program to ensure stakeholders are complete partners in ensuring a safe and healthy environment. Further to develop a communication system where staff and parents are notified of facility issues that may impact health and safety.

2) CUSD staffing allocation should be based upon actual enrollment, not prior year ADA averages.

3) To advocate that the district comply with the provisions of the Brown Act, be responsive to Public Records requests and to support a CUSD culture where issues are discussed in a positive non-threatening environment that supports and encourages civil communication and mutual respect. To work to ensure a culture of transparency and truthful communication.

State Level Advocacy Platform

1) To work to enact legislation to strengthen penalties for Education Code violations committed by school district administrators or employees in relation to misuse of student records.
