



DID YOU KNOW?

- Teen drivers are found at fault in **66%** of **ALL FATAL** collisions that they are involved in, although they only represent **4%** of the state's licensed drivers.
- The leading cause of **DEATH** for Americans 15 - 20 years old is motor vehicle collisions.
- 65 % of teen passenger deaths occur when another teenager is driving.

WHAT IS THE START SMART PROGRAM?

The California Highway Patrol's Start Smart program is a free driver safety education classes which targets new and future licensed teenage drivers between the **ages of 15 - 20** and their parents/guardians. CHP officers will discuss traffic collision avoidance techniques, collision causing factors, driver/parent responsibilities, and seatbelt usage.
